



More parents with rural addresses could be eligible for 30 hours of free childcare for their 3 or 4 year old!

Checking eligibility is very easy; all you need to do is...

- Ensure you meet the national eligibility criteria families where both parents are working (or the sole parent is working in a lone-parent family) and each parent earns the equivalent of 16 hours a week at the national minimum or living wage and earns less than £100,000 a year. - **Visit www.northumberland.gov.uk** and type your post code into My Place (top right hand side of the home page) and click on the Extended Entitlement 30 hour childcare option within the education subheading.

• You will be given access to submit the application and declaration form by Wednesday 18th May.

What will happen next.....

• You will be contacted via email by end of May/beginning of June 2016 with regards to your eligibility and if appropriate details of any evidence required.
