

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Seal going for goals : Can describe self in positive terms and talk about abilities and take pride in their achievements. Talking about the things we do well and planning our activities through talk partners .
- Accessing activities independently

Communication and Language Development

- Join in with repeated refrains and begin to recall stories through puppet play/ role play and story maps
- Maintain attention and following instructions
- Who/what/where/how/why?

Literacy

- Beginning to recognise and identify our name.
- Writing our names and using identifiable letters in our writing
- Phase 1,2 and 3 letters and sounds
- Writing sentences and beginning to develop simple narratives (story maps)
- To encourage vocabulary influenced by story sacks, books and other media

Mathematics

- Careful counting (5,10,20)
- Sorting into two or three groups
- 2d and 3d shapes.
- Repeating patterns
- Records, using marks that they can interpret and explain (number sentences)
- Begins to identify own mathematical problems based on own interests and fascinations.
- Sequencing familiar events

Physical Development

- Music and movement
- Throwing, rolling and catching balls hoops etc
- Awareness of changes to our body during exercise
- Developing fine motor skills with playdough finger gym

Understanding the world

- Completes a simple program on a computer.
- Uses ICT hardware to interact with age-appropriate computer software.
- Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.
- Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change (melting and freezing)
- Artic animals and polar regions
