Samaritan's Purse -Shoe Box Appeal

If you would like to take part in this year's appeal, there are some details below of gift suggestions for your shoe box or please call into the office to collect an Operation Christmas Child leaflet from the Samaritan's purse. Gift Suggestions

Toys – dolls, toy trucks, stuffed animals (with CE label) harmonicas, yo-yo's, skipping ropes, balls etc.

School Supplies – pens, pencils, sharpeners, crayons, felt pens, writing pads, paper, solar calculator, picture books etc.

Hygiene Items – toothbrush, toothpaste, wrapped soap, comb, flannel etc.

Other Items – hat, gloves, scarf, hair accessories, wind up torch, wrapped sweets (sell by date must be at least March 2017)

DO NOT include used or damaged items, war related items such as toy guns, play soldiers or knives.; chocolate, liquids, medicines, handmade or knitted stuffed toys; anything political, racial or religious; marbles or sharp objects; glass containers, mirrors or fragile items; clothing other than listed above.

The last day for getting the filled shoeboxes to school is THURSDAY 17th NOVEMBER.
