Northumbria Police: For your awareness - psychoactive substances wrapped up as sweets

Last week, we issued an appeal to the public via social media to be mindful of the following products - psychoactive substances wrapped up as sweets and to contact police with their concerns or to report suspected drug dealing.

There were two seizures totalling more than 100 packages: one in Bedlington and one in North Shields.

This bulletin is purely to make you aware of the presence of these products.

Importantly, at this time:

*There have been no reports of children being sold or given these products

*We have had no reports of children consuming these products

*There is currently no evidence to show that these drugs are directly marketed to children



On close inspection, the packaging states what they contain. The packaging is not a direct replica of brand name confectionery, but a spoof.

Two men, aged 28 and 20, were arrested on suspicion of drug offences. They have since been released under investigation.
