Safe in the Sun

We hope to see more sun over the rest of the term so please ensure your children are protected from the sun. Remember we cannot apply suncream on children but can supervise and support children to put it on. A hat is very useful to protect from the sun - please write your child's name inside. Please remember your child needs a water bottle especially in the warmer weather.

Seaton Delaval First School Roadmap

All cleaning and sanitising of the school areas will continue as will using sanitiser and washing hands regularly for children and staff.

Week beginning 17th May

- · Social distancing is still needed within the school grounds.
- · Wearing of face masks is still required on the school site.
- •Although it is safe to meet larger groups outside please remember, to keep us all safe, that indoors only groups of 6 or two households should meet.

Week beginning 21st June-to be confirmed.

- No social distancing necessary on the school grounds but latest advice is to keep 2 meters apart from people that you don't live with unless you have formed a support bubble with them.
- School times to go back to normal for all year groups which is an 8.50am start and 3.00pm finish. Red class begins at 8.45 and ends at 11.45. Doors will be closed and locked promptly meaning children who regularly arrive late may not be admitted through the main office.
- · Children can begin to work in groups and sit together in groups from other classes.
- Children will be able to sit with their friends at lunchtime from across the school and will go to the hatch to collect their lunch. We will slowly phase classes into the hall and monitor the impact.

- Reception and Years 1 and 2 will play on the KS1 yard while 3 and 4 will be able to play with each other at the back of the school and in the MUGA at lunchtimes.
- A themed week will be centred on 'The Olympics/Road to Tokyo' where they will learn about the values and ethos of the games and experience Paralympic activities.
- \cdot We will have Summer Concerts for Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 children 7^{th} and 8^{th} July [to be confirmed]
- We will have a Year 4 leaver's assembly so parents can celebrate with us their child's journey through Seaton Delaval First School [15th July to be confirmed].

Transition

We hope that we can have a transition morning for all our children on Thursday 8th July as long as the restrictions are lifted.
