Mathematics

Joining in with number rhymes
Using numbers accurately in play
Counting in order to 5, 10 and beyond.

Using numbers: Counting reliably with numbers

SSM: Explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

Recognise, create and describe patterns.

Securing Numbers: Place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer.
