Mathematics

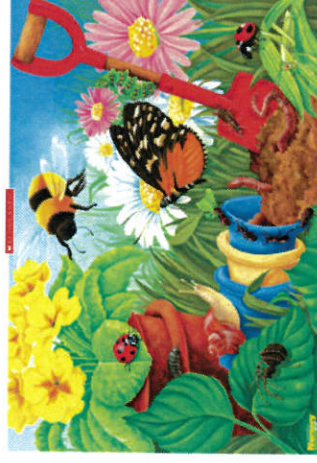
- Ladybird counting and doubling caterpillar number game.
