Dear Parent,

We propose to take the children in Reception Purple and Reception/Year 1 Green class on a visit to Whitehouse Farm on Wednesday 23rd November 2016. The coach will leave school at 9.15am and return to school at 2.45pm (both times are approximate).

Children can wear sensible clothing but must wear a school sweatshirt or cardigan, this is so the children are easily recognisable as there may be other schools visiting at the same time. As the children will be doing a lot of walking, sensible shoes or trainers must be worn. Please make sure your child wears a warm waterproof coat.

Your child is entitled to a packed lunch provided by the school. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch kindly complete the form below. The school packed lunch will consist of a cheese sandwich, a packet of quavers, a muffin, an apple and a bottle of water. If you don't want a school packed lunch, you will need to provide your child with a packed lunch and a drink in a small container (no fizzy drinks or microwaveable meals please.) The children will not need any spending money.

If you would like your child to go on the trip kindly fill in the reply slip below and return to school no later than Friday 11th November 2016.

If your child suffers from travel sickness please inform their class teacher and where necessary give them a travel sickness tablet before coming to school.

The children are requested to bring a donation of £6.00 towards the total cost of the trip which is £11.80, the remainder will be subsidised by school.

The governors understand that some families may have difficulty contributing the full amount. It is their wish that no child is deprived of the experience because of a lack of funds, therefore please contribute what you can afford and the remainder will be met from monies raised through school fund raising events.
