Dear Parent/Carer,

We propose to take the children in Years 2, 3 and 4 to Seaton Delaval Hall on Friday 8th November 2019. We will leave school at 9am and return at 1pm (both times are approximate).

Children can wear sensible clothing but must wear a school sweatshirt or cardigan, this is so the children are easily recognisable as there may be other schools visiting the same areas at the same time. As we will be walking to Seaton Delaval Hall please make sure your child wears sensible footwear and wears a warm waterproof coat.

If you pay for your child's meals, you will need to provide a packed lunch and a drink in a small container (no fizzy drinks or microwaveable meals please.)

If your child is entitled to an income related free school meal or a universal free school meal, they will be entitled to a packed lunch provided by the school. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch kindly complete the form below. The school packed lunch will consist of a cheese sandwich, a packet of quavers, a cookie, an apple and a bottle of water. If you don't want a school packed lunch you will need to provide a packed lunch and a drink. The children will not need any spending money.

If it is a dry day the children will eat their packed lunch in the grounds of Seaton Delaval Hall otherwise they will have a picnic in school when they return.
