Moving on to... Purple Class [Reception]

A guide for children and parents

Their class teachers will be Mrs Derrick and Mrs Charlton.

Daily routines

Purple Class children and parents are welcome to use both entrance gates to the school. The doors (classroom door leading on to the Early Years outdoor area - please see map) open at 8:50am, and children are asked to be at their classroom by this time. Children will then stay in their classroom for group time.

Pegs for coats are located outside the classroom in the porch area. Children should bring their water bottles and packed lunches with them into the classroom.

School lunches must be ordered on Monday morning for the following week.

We would ask Purple Class parents to line up at the red gate where children will be collected by a member of staff at 8.50am prompt. Mrs Derrick or Mrs Charlton will be available briefly to answer any queries you may have.

Children should hand in any money (in a named envelope) and slips or letters as soon as they come in to the classroom. Mrs Derrick or Mrs Charlton will take the register.

Children in Purple Class get a piece of fresh fruit every day free of charge. Parents who would like their child to have milk should complete and return a milk slip with payment, as required, to the school office.

The class will have weekly Movement lessons in the school hall developing into **PE lessons** in the Summer Term as part of our extensive transition work. Parents who wish their child to be excused from PE for medical reasons should inform Mrs Derrick or Mrs Charlton before school or via a note.

Lunchtime routines

Children in Purple Class will be dismissed for lunchtime at 11:50am. They will have their lunch in the dining room, irrespective of whether they have school meals or packed lunches. They will then play on the yard or the field (weather permitting).

End of the day routines

The school day ends at 3:00pm for Purple Class children. Please collect Purple Class children the Early Years outdoor area red gate. Parents who also have to collect other children are asked to collect their youngest children first and walk around to the other yard to collect any older children. Staff will wait in their porch until your older children are collected. In order to ensure their safety, children in Purple Class are not allowed to go to the other yard on their own, or leave the premises without an adult.

Other information

Homework will be given out each week on Friday and should be returned by Thursday of the next week. Please help to support your child's

learning by ensuring their homework is returned on time, and inform the class teacher if there are any problems with this. Children will have their own reading book relating to the school scheme which is matched to their reading age. This will be taken home on a nightly basis to read with parents / carers. A reading diary should be used as a two way communication with home. Individual reading will take place twice every week with an adult in school.

You will be invited to attend a parents' meeting every term. Mrs Derrick or Mrs Charlton will talk to you about your child's learning and the progress they are making.
