Urgent: Grooming homeless young people risk

Intelligence has emerged that young people are being referred to homeless projects in order to groom other young people. Young people affected by homelessness are a high risk group that may be targeted because of their isolation and vulnerability. It has been suggested that young people are being exploited through sex, legal highs and organised begging. If you do have any concerns please contact:
