## Daily routines

The Purple Class doors [at the front of the school] open at **8:45am**, and children are asked to be at their classroom by this time.

Pegs for coats and bags are located to the rear of the classroom. Children should bring their water bottles with them. Please make sure that your child's belongings are named.

We would ask Purple Class parents to line up at the entrance where children will be collected by a member of staff at 8.45am prompt. Mrs Vallely will be available briefly to answer any queries you may have.

Children should hand in any money (in a named envelope) and slips or letters as soon as they come in to the classroom. Mrs Vallely will take the register.

Children in Purple Class get a piece of fresh fruit every day free of charge. Parents who would like their child to have milk should completed the form sent out via email and text.

The class will have two **PE lessons** every week (to be confirmed). Parents who wish their child to be excused from PE for medical reasons should inform Mrs Vallely before school or via a note.

#### Lunchtime routines

Children in Purple Class will be dismissed for lunchtime at 11:45am. They will have their lunch in the dining room, irrespective of whether they have school meals or packed lunches. They will then play on the yard or the field (weather permitting).

### End of the day routines

The school day ends at 3:15pm for Purple Class children. Please collect Purple Class children at the classroom door at the front of the school. Parents who also have to collect other children are asked to collect their youngest children first and walk around to the other yard to collect any older children. Staff will wait in their porch until your older children are collected. In order to ensure their safety, children in Purple Class are not allowed to go to the other yard on their own, or leave the premises without an adult.

#### Other information

Homework will be given out each week on Thursday and should be returned by Tuesday of the next week. Please help to support your child's learning by ensuring their homework is returned on time, and inform the class teacher if there are any problems with this. Children will have their own reading book relating to the school scheme which is matched to their reading age. This will be taken home on a nightly basis to read with parents / carers and needs to be in

school every day. A reading diary should be used as a two way communication with home.

Individual reading will take place every week with an adult in school.

You will be invited to attend a parents' meeting every term. Mrs Vallely will talk to you about your child's learning and the progress they are making.
