Parent - teacher consultation

We believe it is essential to have periodic meetings with parents in order to discuss the progress of their children.

<u>Aims:</u>

• To invite parents to termly meetings to discuss the progress of their children.

<u>Procedure:</u>

Frequency

• Parent-Teacher Consultations to be held at least once a term.

Venue

• A secure central venue will be used for these consultations [the main hall].

Discussion Points

- A set number of discussion points will be used as a basis for each meeting such as:
 - General progress of pupil
 - Progress since last consultation
 - Identified areas of concern
 - Effort in class
 - Presentation of work
 - Behaviour
 - Relationships with other children
 - Relationships with adults
 - Attendance
 - Punctuality
 - Targets for the term / IEPs
 - Contact details

Feedback

• Staff will meet at a later date to feedback on these consultations.

Follow up

• There might be occasions when there is need to hold further follow up meetings in order to discuss issues further.

Reporting

- Governors will be informed of attendance figures via the Headteacher's Report to Governors.
- Parents will be informed via Newsletters.
