Dear Parent/Carer,

On behalf of the staff I would like to wish you all a Happy New Year.

We are now tier 4 restrictions and to minimise the risk of school having to fully close we would like all adults to comply with the following procedures:

Wear a face covering while on school grounds i.e. car park, yard, pavements etc Please do not wait for other parents in the playground

Do not stand in large groups in the playground

Keep your distance

Do not allow children to play on the trim trail

Do not allow children from different classes or bubbles to play together in the playground unless they are siblings.

Your child must bring a water bottle to school every day because we cannot give them a drink of water from a cup due to current regulations.

On PE days remember the school uniform is white t-shirt, black shorts and joggers/leggings.

Children must wear a jumper or cardigan everyday as classroom windows will be open for ventilation in accordance with government guidelines.

Children should only bring to school a water bottle, their reading book and a packed lunch box/snack box.

This is to minimise the risk of the new COVID strain and the risk of transmission to you, your children and staff.

Should the school have to close we will begin distance learning which will be English, Maths and Topic tasks daily. This is part of the curriculum and the Government expects children to continue their learning at home. If you do not have access to a computer you can e-mail and request a paper copy of the work.
