Dear Parent,

You and your child are invited on a visit to Whitehouse Farm, Morpeth on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2018. The coach will leave school at 9.15am and return to school at 2.45pm (both times are approximate).

Children can wear sensible clothing but must wear a school sweatshirt or cardigan; this is so the children are easily recognisable as there may be other schools visiting at the same time. As the children will be doing a lot of walking and the weather is changeable, it is advised that your child wears a waterproof coat and sensible shoes/wellies

Your child will need to carry a packed lunch and bring a drink in a small container (no fizzy drinks please or microwavable meals).

We require names of parents and children who wish to attend as soon as possible so that we can proceed with organising transport. If you and your child wish to attend the trip kindly fill in the reply slip below and return to school no later than Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018.

(Due to health and safety regulations your child will not be able to go on the trip without a parent/guardian and unfortunately siblings are not allowed to attend.)

The children are requested to bring a donation of £6.00 per child towards the total cost of the trip which is £13.24, the remainder will be subsidised by school.

The governors understand that some families may have difficulty contributing the full amount. It is their wish that no child is deprived of the experience because of a lack of funds, therefore please contribute what you can afford and the remainder will be met from monies raised through school fund raising events.

PLEASE NOTE THE NURSERY WILL BE CLOSED MORNING AND AFTERROON TO THOSE WHO ARE NOT ATTENDING THE TRIP ON 19<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2018.
